TIGRE

620 NE 78th Street, Miami

ust steps away from one of Miami's busiest intersections is a waterfront restaurant and cocktail bar that resembles a hidden sanctuary. Tigre's indoor/ outdoor property captures the serenity of river life with more than 100 feet of breezeway seating, elegant botanicals, views of manatees and pelicans, and an intimate art nouveau interior. Named after a town just minutes north of Buenos Aires, Tigre was created by three Argentine friends who-upon seeing the property's signature waterfront deck—were reminded of long summer weekends spent fishing by a river and sipping ice-cold maté under an orange tree. Chef Deborah de Corral is the creative mind behind the modern take on Argentine cuisine. Eduardo Suarez, founder and designer of Casa Florida in Miami and Shelter Pizza, Rosarito Fish Shack and El Almacén in New York City, applied his unique eye to Tigre's design. Marcos

Chantres, involved in the development of local and national brands and a veteran in the hospitality business, is the food and beverage director. Tigre's menu features an array of small plates (many of them based on Argentine classics with a contemporary elevated approach), a number of vegetable-forward dishes and a variety of perfectly grilled meats and seafood. The full bar specializes in aperitifs and original handcrafted cocktails, in addition to a carefully curated wine list highlighting Argentine labels. "I'm always after that balance between bold flavors, freshness and contrast in texture," de Corral says. "My aim is to stimulate your palate and your mind, but my ultimate goal is to uplift your spirit and make you happy."

Situated in a grand 19th-century building, the Mandarin Oriental Hyde Park overlooks two opposing aspects of London: bucolic Hyde Park to the north, bustling Knightsbridge to the south.
